

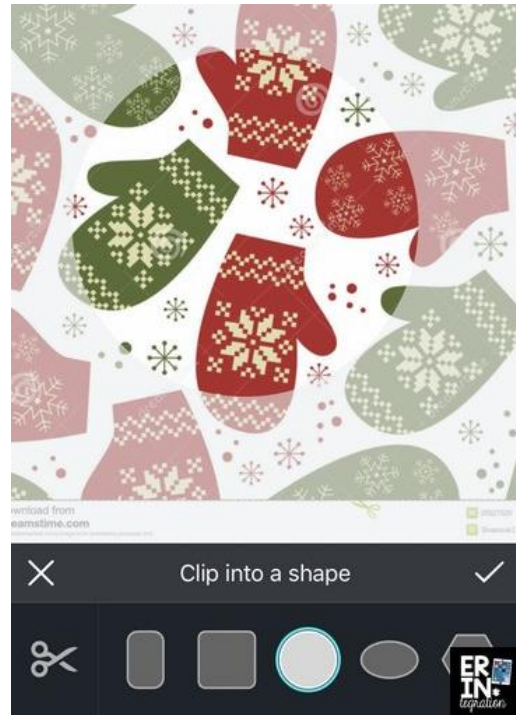
CIRCLE PATCHWORK DIGITAL CHRISTMAS TREE WITH PIC COLLAGE

1 In Pic Collage, use the web image search tool to get your “patchwork” images. You might like to add a colour to the search if you want a colour theme. I chose 16 squares for the project.



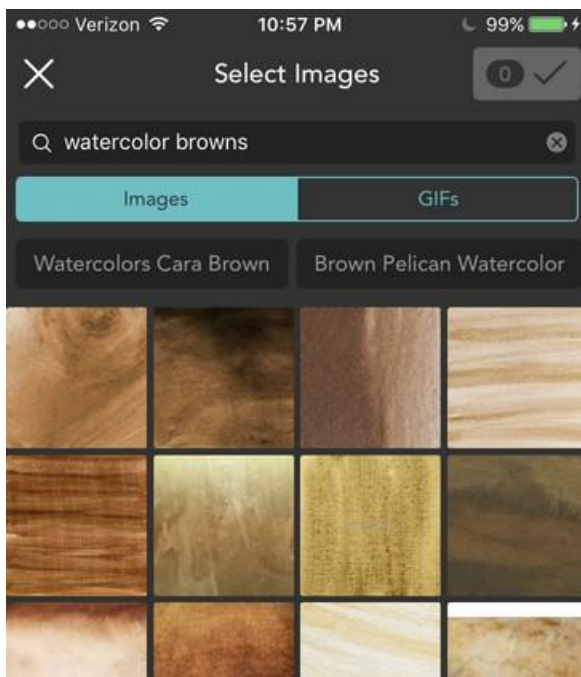
2 Pic Collage will insert all the images as squares. You will need to trim each square one at a time by double tapping then choosing Clip.

3 In the clip menu, choose the circle. Clip all the circles separately. For my example, I used my fingers to drag and pinch my circles into various sizes.

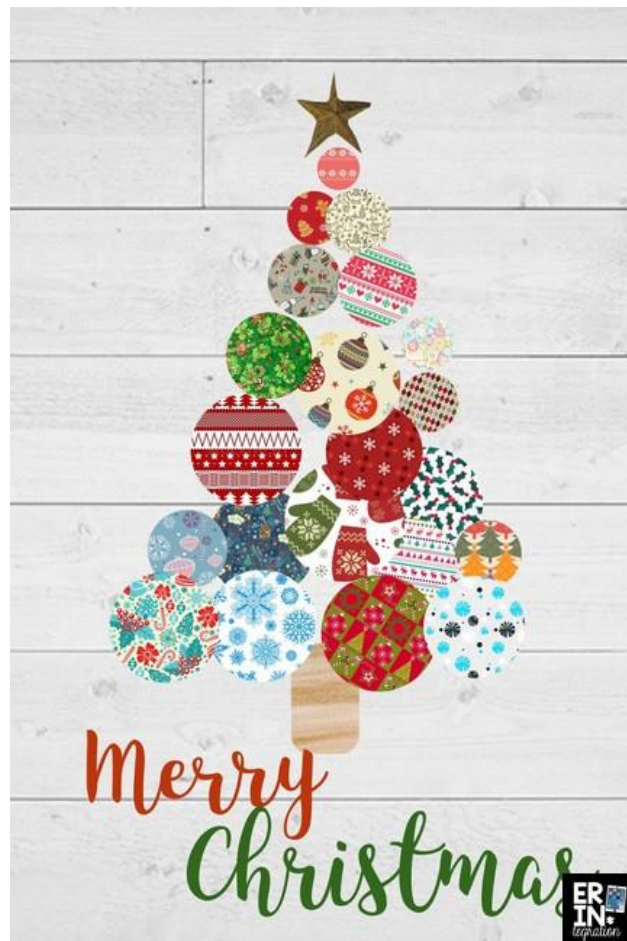


4 Use the web search tool to search for “star png” (png files have transparent backgrounds) and insert it onto the tree.

5 For the trunk, I used the image search tool and searched ‘watercolour browns’ to pull up various water colour textures. I chose a texture and used the clip tool and the cylinder shape to create my own stump.



6 Arrange the circles and stump into a tree shape. You may need to use the ordering tool to send things forward / bring them to the front.



7 Finally use the text tool to add your first name and the name of your school. You can also add a Christmas message if you wish.
